An outline of the program, rules and regulations along with consequences are as follows:

#### I. ACTIVITIES

##### 1. Downhill Skiing

1. Cost \$63.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. Cost with Season Pass or Vertical Value Card \$45.00 – Payable to Teton High School
3. Ticket with VVC needs to be bought at Grand Targhee.
4. Rental, if needed - \$15.00 for ½ day payable to Grand Targhee each week or \$60.00 for four weeks
5. Insurance or waiver required

##### 2. Snowboarding

1. Cost \$63.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. Cost with Season Pass or Vertical Value Card \$45.00 – Payable to Teton High School
3. Ticket with VVC needs to be bought at Grand Targhee.
4. Rental, if needed (limited to 30 on first come basis) - \$20.00 for ½ day payable to Grand Targhee each week or \$80.00 for four weeks (not available on scholarship) I
5. Insurance or waiver required

##### 3. Ice Climbing

1. Cost \$57.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. Transportation included
3. Insurance and waiver required
4. Limited to 8 Students (Signature required, See the office)

##### 4. Swimming

1. Cost \$25.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. Transportation included
3. Insurance or waiver required
4. Limited to 40 students

##### 5. Digital Photography (school cameras available, but use of own camera is recommended)

1. Cost \$20.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. Transportation included
3. Insurance or waiver required
4. Limited to 12 students (Signature required, see Mrs. Woolley)

## **6. Regional Cooking**

1. Cost \$30.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. No insurance or waiver
3. Limited to 25 students (Signature required, See Mrs. Buxton)

## **7. Scrapbooking**

1. Cost \$25.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. No insurance or waiver
3. Limited to 20 students (Signature required, See the office)

## **8. Soccer Indoor Scrimmage**

1. Cost \$5.00
2. Limited to 40 students (Signature required, See Mr. Romano)
3. Insurance or waiver required

## **9. Beginning Chess**

1. Cost \$5.00
2. No insurance or waiver
3. Limited to 20 Students

## **10. Film Photography – Using Darkroom (should provide own camera)**

1. Cost \$20.00 – Payable to Teton High School
2. Transportation included
3. Insurance or Waiver required
4. Limited to 10 students (Signature required, See Mrs. Woolley)

**11. Study Hall/Movies/Board Games– Student will automatically be enrolled in study hall if they do not choose an activity.**

## **II. RULES**

- B. Students must stay with the same activity the entire four week period
- C. Transportation to and from will be provided by the school district. NO driving personal cars.
- D. Students must ride the bus and will only be released to parents or guardian
- E. Students must actively be engaged and participate as instructor dictates
